II. Faculty Credential Guidelines and Requirements

The Higher Learning Commission (NCS HLC), the national accrediting body is waukee College, provides guidance in determining qualified full time and adjunct faculty. In general terms qualified faculty consist of "people who by formal education and tested experience know what students must learn." Such faculty "create the curricular pathways through which students gain the competencies and skills they need."

V. International Credential Evaluation

In order to place an individual with transcripts from foreign countries in the appropriate job situation his/her educational background abroad will need to be evaluated in terms of U.S. "equivalency." Kishwa@elege requires that all international crelential evaluations be conducted by an accredited third party organization. Advisory statements on educational equivalency are prepared on request for colleges and universities, professional associations and public school systems.

VI. Credential Hiring Sandards by Discipline/Course

1.1 **Transfer**Those teaching for transfer general education courses and

a master's degree in the content area or a master's degree plus 18 semester hours of graduate level credit in the discipline of instruction.

1.2 Occupational/TechnicalThoseteaching in nontransfer courses

must have a bachelor's degree in the field and/or a combination of educati, training and tested experience.

Individuals who do not explicitly meet college minimum degree and course work requirements can be justified on an individual basis by documenting other qualifications.

- 1.4 Remedial EducationThose teaching remedial ourses must have a bachelor's degree.
- 1.6 Adult EducationThose teaching adult educationmust have a bachelor's degree.
